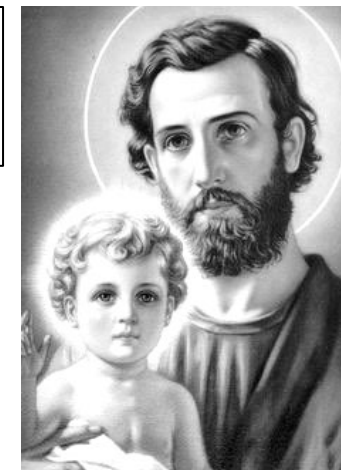
NEWS AND IMPORTANT DATES
