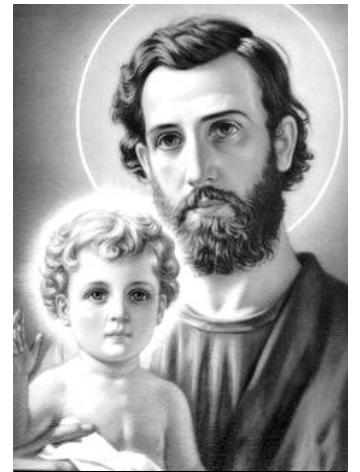
NEWS AND IMPORTANT DATES

-Ash Wednesday Masses: 7:00 am and 7:00 pm. BEFORE Ash Wednesday, we will be burning old palms and old sacramentals. Please put your items in the collection basket at the back of Church by Monday, March 4th. Thank you!

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--March 10, we will have a second collection for the Church in Central and Eastern Europe, which goes primarily to the former Soviet countries, which struggle with extreme poverty due to many years of communist rule. This collection is normally taken on Ash Wednesday, but we will be taking the collection on March 10 instead.

-Reglas de la Cuaresma:

- El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo son días de Ayuno y Abstinencia
- Los Viernes son días de Abstinencia

El Ayuno indica que puede comer tres comidas (dos pequeñas y una grande) sin comer entre las comidas. Desayuno, Almuerzo, y la Cena...nada más. Es un requisito para los de las edades entre 18-59 años.

La Abstinencia indica que **NO** puede comer carne. La abstinencia es un requisito para los que tiene más que 18 años.

Carne: si camina o vuela, es carne. No res, no vaca, no pollo, no puerco, no pavo, etc. Si vive toda su vida, o la mayoría de su vida, en el mar, sí se puede comer (peces, tortuga, cocodrilo, rana, camarones, et cetera). Puede comer “Productos de Carne”: huevos, queso, leche.

Como siempre, hay unas excepciones. No tiene que seguir esas reglas si:

- Tiene menos que 18 años o más que 59 años
- Está enfermo (es una excepción de unos días)
- Tiene una enfermedad crónica (cáncer, diabetes, et cetera—una excepción por toda la cuaresma)
- Está embarazada

-Rules for Lent:

- Ash Wednesday and Good Friday: Days of Fasting and Abstinence
- Fridays: Days of Abstinence

Fasting means you may three meals (two small meals and one larger one) with no snacks in between.

Fasting is required for those between the ages of 18-59.

Abstinence means that you do not eat meat on these days. Abstinence is required for those older than 18.

Meat is anything that walks or flies (beef, poultry, pork)—any thing that spends most or all of its life in water may be eaten: fish, frog, gator, turtle, shellfish, etc. “Meat Product” may also be eaten: broth, cheese, milk, eggs, etc.

You are not required to follow these requirements if you are:

- Outside the ages listed above
- Sick (temporary exemption)
- Chronically ill (cancer, diabetes, etc.)
- Pregnant
