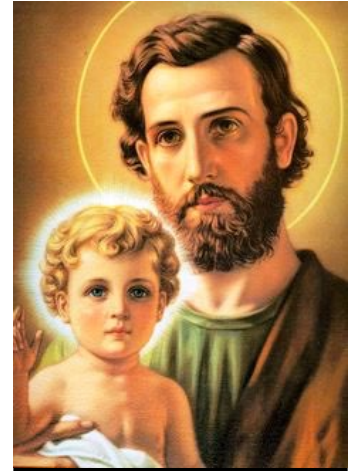

**Report from the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year:**

*Total Income: \$79,220.00*

*Total Expenses: \$76,638.00*

**NET INCOME: \$2,582.00**

*Total in Checking: \$34,845.00 (as of 28 June 2019).*

*Total Joy of the Gospel Rebates : \$12,380.00*

*(We will not see anything from this again after Dec. 2019)*

*Utilities were significantly higher over this year due to various causes, specifically with heating and air, but that will be corrected, as we have changed our utility plan to be more stable and less dependent on the weather outside. This will save us a considerable amount. Various liturgical expenses, licensing, antivirus protection, and advertising are also a cause for the high expenses, as well as various repairs throughout the parish.*

*Examples: Crucifix :\$2,300.00*

*Natural gas bill: -\$4,000.00—this is a huge chunk*
