-January 1 is the feast of the Motherhood of Mary, and it is a Holy Day of Obligation. As per usual, we will have three Masses to celebrate that day. Dec. 31 at 5:30 pm., Jan. 1 at 7 am and 12:15 pm. **A Reminder:** missing Mass on a Holy Day of Obligation is a mortal sin, the same penalty as missing Mass on a Sunday, and you may not receive Communion until you have gone to Confession. It doesn't matter where you go to Mass, as long as you go somewhere.
