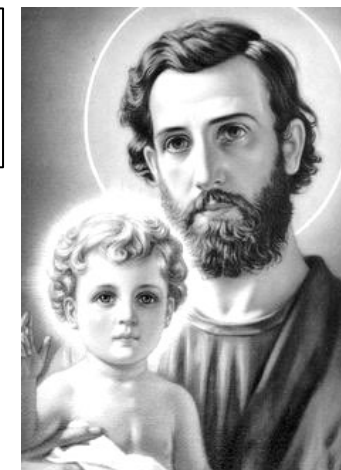

All priests, religious, readers/lectors, acolytes, catechists, Knights of Columbus, and anyone who will have direct contact with minors at the parish level are required to undergo Safe Environment training. This training must be renewed annually and the corresponding background check is to be renewed every five years. If you have not yet done either of these, please do so. You can start by going online for the training, which will have instructions and will take about 45 minutes to one hour.
