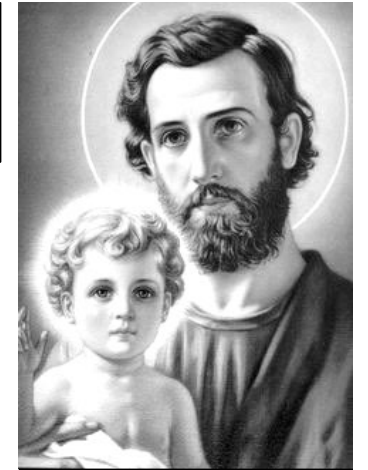
**NEWS AND IMPORTANT DATES**
